 field Township Bradford County Pa and Clarissa his wife parties of the  
 first part and Erasmus Cleveland of the place aforesaid of the second  
 part It appears that the said parties of the first part for and in consideration  
 of the sum of Nine Hundred and Fifty Dollars lawful money of the United

States to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part at or before the sealing or delivery hereof  
 the said parties of the first part do hereby acknowledge and forever discharge the said party of the  
 second part his heirs executors and administrators by their presents having granted being since sold aliened  
 enfeoffed released and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release convey  
 and confirm unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns all that certain messuage  
 lot piece or parcel of land being and lying in the Township of Springfield Bradford County Pennsylvania  
 more bounded as follows, viz: On the South by the public highway leading from Smithfield to Secaucus  
 Station On the West by a line of Wallace M. Grace from the North by  
 a line of Secaucus to Secaucus Station On the East by a line of Secaucus to Secaucus Station
