Was af. jeweler, artist, and penman; rem. 1816 to Springfield, Pa., and 1821 to Troy, Pa., miller; ret. 1825 to Springf., Pa., built flour mill, operated it several years, then bought farm. Dwelt finally at Fairview, Ia. He was enterprising and much respected.
