MARRIAGE AFFIDAVIT

The State of Kansas, Miami County, ss.

IN THE PROBATE COURT OF SAID COUNTY AND STATE.

Lloyd H. Hawley hereby applies for a MARRIAGE LICENSE addressed to any minister or magistrate authorized by law to unite in matrimony Lloyd H. Hawley and Emma C. Skeens and being duly sworn deposes:

That said Lloyd H. Hawley is 21 years of age, and that said Emma C. Skeens is aged 18 years; that they have their parents' consent to said union, and that neither has been divorced within six months last past.

That said contracting parties are not related to each other in any of the degrees prohibited by law, namely: parent and child, grandparent and grandchild in any degree, brother and sister of the whole or half blood, uncle or niece, aunt or nephew, nor first cousins.

That neither of said parties is or ever has been epileptic, imbecile, feeble-minded, or insane; or, if either is or has ever been so afflicted, then that the woman is more than forty-five years of age.

And that neither party was born subsequent to the insanity of either of his or her parents; or, if so, that the woman about to be married is more than forty-five years of age.
